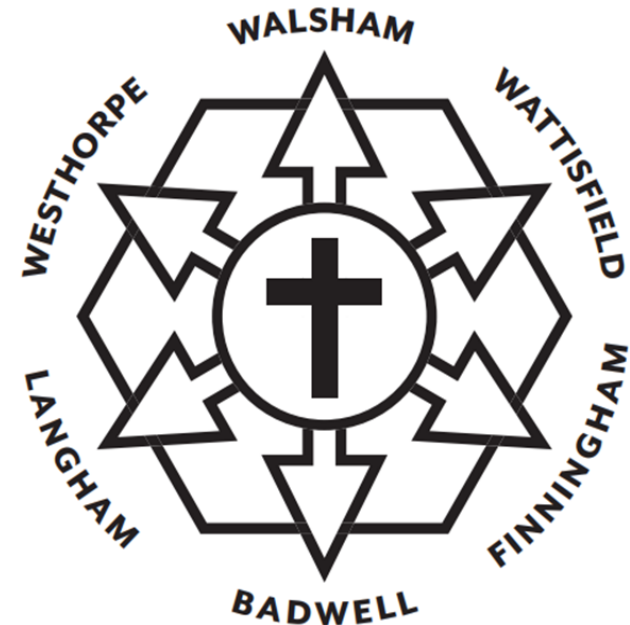

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A SUMMER INVITATION TO STOP AND STARE

"What is this life if, full of care,
We have no time to stand and stare.
No time to stand beneath the boughs
And stare as long as sheep or cows.
No time to see, when woods we pass,
Where squirrels hide their nuts in grass.
No time to see, in broad daylight,
Streams full of stars, like skies at night.
No time to turn at Beauty's glance,

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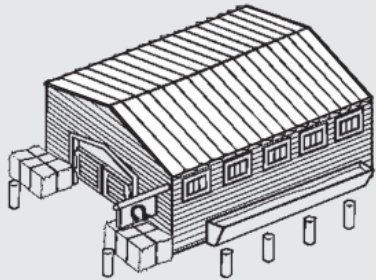

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NOTES FROM THE GARDEN

WOW! At this time last year I wrote about how hot and dry it had been in June, this year it has been a record breaking year for temperatures in June ever. This makes planning, planting and growing plants very difficult. Some plants and shrubs like these conditions but others are struggling. Vegetable crops like potatoes and other root crops suffer. The yield is down and the skins on the potatoes when it is dry set hard so smaller potatoes are produced. Watering these plants is not only expensive, but a lot of soaking is needed to get down into the soil, or else the potatoes will come up to the surface for it.

Flower plants in tubs, pots and baskets, and borders may look good in the sunshine, but the constant heat day and night will dry the soil very quickly. As gardeners we then have to adapt to the changing climate, preparing the flower holders needing ever more attention when planting up. Using plenty of homemade compost to mix with the bought compost to help retain moisture longer and in the case of pots, baskets and tubs leave a bigger gap at the top to insure water is retained and not spilt down the side.

In August harvesting crops is now in full swing. Potatoes are now ready to dig up and dry off on the surface of the soil, onions and shallots also. This is the only benefit of constant dry sunny weather as crops need to be dried thoroughly ready to be stored for winter use. In the Polytunnel cucumbers and tomatoes are in abundance. Here you have more control over watering and weeding. Pick crops constantly so they will continue to produce more. Salad crops such as lettuce, spinach and chard are thriving, now is the time to sow salad crops seed for continued cropping.

In September keep dead heading your flowers as this will prolong the flowering until the first frosts appear. These changing weather patterns are a bonus for fruit crops. Apples and pears are ready for picking and storing in a cool dry place, checking regularly so as to remove rotten fruits. Keep feeding pots,

baskets and containers, also take time to sit and ponder around your plot and garden, and soak in the fruits of your labour, and eat your healthy crops.

Hopefully it will rain again very soon! On August Bank Holiday we will be opening our garden along with a lot of other people in the village in Walsham Le Willows. It is a very good event, beautiful gardens and a lot of fun for all. Hope to see you then to compare notes from the garden 'live'.

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I've recently had to give up work due to a back injury and I'm worried about how I'm going to cope with the drop in income. I'm not sure what benefits I can get - where should I start?

Lots of people miss out on benefits they're entitled to, so it's worth checking what you can get.

Claiming benefits also means you can get access to other financial help like cost-of-living payments and discounts on energy and transport.

To get started, you can use an online benefits calculator. For the most accurate answer, you'll need information about your savings, income, pension, childcare payments and any existing benefits for you and your partner, if you have one. You can use the Entitledto benefits calculator (<https://www.entitledto.co.uk/>) or Policy in Practice version (<https://www.betteroffcalculator.co.uk/login>) for a detailed overview. The Turn2us online tool (<https://benefits-calculator.turn2us.org.uk/>) can provide a quick idea of what benefits and other financial help you might be eligible for.

The main benefit available for most people of working age is Universal Credit. You should check if you can get Universal Credit if you're over 18 and under State Pension age you can check your State Pension age on the government website (<https://www.gov.uk/state-pension-age>), and if you have less than £16,000 in savings or other investments. You can check if you're eligible on the Citizens Advice website.

If you're finding it difficult to work because of your injury, you might get more Universal Credit or not have to look for work. You'll need to inform the Department for Work and Pensions that you have a health condition when you claim Universal Credit and, if possible, submit a fit note. You can find out more on the Citizens Advice website.

You might be entitled to other benefits depending on your situation, like your age, if you're disabled or if you have a child. Some people can claim more than one benefit - for example, disability benefits such as Personal Independence Payment (if you're under pension age) or Attendance Allowance (if you're over pension age) and Universal Credit. These disability benefits aren't means-tested and can often be claimed in addition to other benefits like Universal Credit. Look at our website for more details.

If your medical condition makes it difficult to work, you may also be entitled to the new-style Employment and Support Allowance (ESA). Check if you can claim ESA on our website.

If you pay council tax, you might be able to get a reduction in your bill. You can check if you can pay less council tax on the Citizens Advice website.

There is also help available if you don't have enough money to live on. You might be able to get extra money from the government, your local council or a charity. Find out more about the support you can get with the cost of living on the Citizens Advice website.

if you're still not sure, remember you don't have to face this alone. Our advisers can help to check what benefits and financial support you might be entitled to and help you find a way forward.

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HASSLEBACK COURGETTE BAKE

Ingredients

4 courgettes,
2 x 400g tins chopped tomatoes
400g tin borlotti beans,
onion, finely chopped
2 tsp harissa paste,
2 garlic cloves, crushed
2 tsp ground cumin,
3 tbsp olive oil
75g panko breadcrumbs,
15g coriander, chopped



Method (Serves 4)

1. Preheat the oven to gas 6, 200°C, fan 180°C. Lay each courgette on its side and carefully make deep slits all the way along the courgette – each slice should cut about three-quarters of the way through the courgette and be spaced about 2mm apart. To make this easier, you can place the courgettes in between the handles of 2 wooden spoons, these will act as a barrier and stop the knife from slicing all the way through.
2. Add the tomatoes, borlotti beans, onion, half the harissa paste and garlic and seasoning to a large roasting tin and stir to combine. Place the courgettes on top of the sauce.
3. In a small bowl, combine the remaining harissa, cumin and 2 tbsp of the oil. Brush the marinade over the courgettes, ensuring it gets down into all the slits. Roast for 30-35 mins until the courgettes are starting to soften.
4. Meanwhile, place the remaining oil and garlic in a bowl with the breadcrumbs and toss to combine.
5. Remove the courgettes from the oven and scatter over the garlic breadcrumbs. Return to the oven for 10 mins until golden and crisp. Scatter with the chopped coriander to serve.
